



- WOS and SCOPUS are the most widespread databases on different scientific field which are frequently used for searching the literature (Guz and Rushchitsky, 2009)






# **Choosing the Right Journal**

- If possible, find journal in the reputable publisher and check in the Scopus Database, SJR, or WOS
- Read carefully the scope of the journal
- Read topics that cover the respective journal
- See who are the editors and reviewers
- Review volumes and issues → What is missing?
- Read min 10 papers of that journal → It is good to see what they accept
- Read the guidelines
- The type of article
- Journal's performance (track record time line publication and the number of article every issue Is it increase significant?)
- Choose open access or closed access



# **Choosing the Right Journal**

### **Journal Finder**

• Some publishers provide the journal finder to find journals that most colsely match your title/abstract

### **Journal metrics**

- Help to select the most appropriate journal
- Types of journal metrics: speed, reach, and impact (Ex. SNIP, SJR, Citescore, IF, Eigenfactor)

### Pay attention to predatory journals

- A publishing business model that is **suspected** to exploit authors and involves:
- 1. charging publication fees to authors without checking (or minimal checking) articles for quality and legitimacy
- 2. providing the accelerated editorial process
- 3. publishing services associated with legitimate journals (open access or not).

# Tips and Trick

- Read the journal guidelines, Read, Read, and Read!
- Don't force submit in journals that are not the topic
- Don't think that paid journals are definitely easy to accept
- Don't ask: are there slots? when is the LOA issued? Even though it's only been submitted for 1 day --> High confidence
- Following the structure of a thesis or research report
- Check your paper to the proofreader
- Make Collaboration
- Never think of committing a violation (unethical publications)
- Create a "list" as an alternative to a journal that will be sent a manuscript, the order of one is priority and so on. Remember: good article will find its right home (journal)





While identifying potential entrepreneurial opportunities as one of benefits obtained from such program may further increase self-efficacy and/or entrepreneurial resilience, suddenly mentioning another concept without the explanation about the linkage with the existing key concepts, it looks like the concept of 'entrepreneurial opportunity'

becomes another mediating factor

Entrepreneurship learning programs assist prisoners in developing broader entrepreneurial skills to be creative and innovative in building their businesses and managing their rapidly changing business environment (Henry et al., 2005). The program is an effort to reduce recidivism rates after being released due to the limited available jobs and discriminatory attitudes of society towards ex-prisoners (Patzelt et al., 2014). Self-efficacy and entrepreneurial resilience are cognitive frameworks for individuals to understand entrepreneurial settings that can be facilitated through entrepreneurial learning, thereby increasing their intention to engage in entrepreneurial activities.
