



- Clarivate – Web of Science (<https://mjl.clarivate.com/>): Journal Citation Report → Journal Impact Factor → Journal Citation Indicator (New Metric)
- Scopus (<https://www.scopus.com/>) – Scimago Journal Rank: SJR, SNIP
- The competition between WOS and SCOPUS databases is intense
- WOS and SCOPUS are the most widespread databases on different scientific field which are frequently used for searching the literature (Guz and Rushchitsky, 2009)

Research Variables

Independent Variable / Predictor Variable (Variable X)

01

The variable that influences the dependent variable in either a positive or negative way.

Dependent Variable / Criterion Variable (Variable y)

02

- The variable of primary interest to the researcher.
- The researcher's goal is to understand and describe the dependent variable, or to explain its variability, or predict it.

Mediating Variable / Intervening Variable

03

- The variable that surfaces between the time the independent variables start operating to influence the dependent variable and the time their impact is felt on it.
- The independent variable can influence dependent variable through the mediating variable.
- To model a process.

Moderating Variable

04

- The variable that has a strong contingent effect on independent variable-dependent variable relationship.
- The third variable that modifies the original relationship between the independent and dependent variables.

You might start with questions (e.g., the questions in your case study protocol) rather than with the data. Start with a small question first, then identify your evidence that addresses the question.

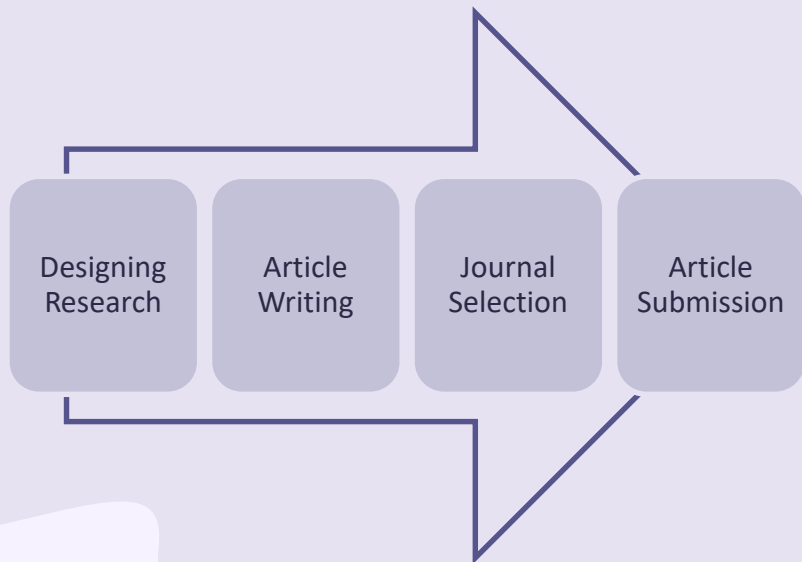


Draw a tentative conclusion based on the weight of the evidence, also asking how you should display the evidence so that readers can check your assessment.



Continue to a larger question and repeat the procedure. Keep going until you think you have addressed your main research question(s).

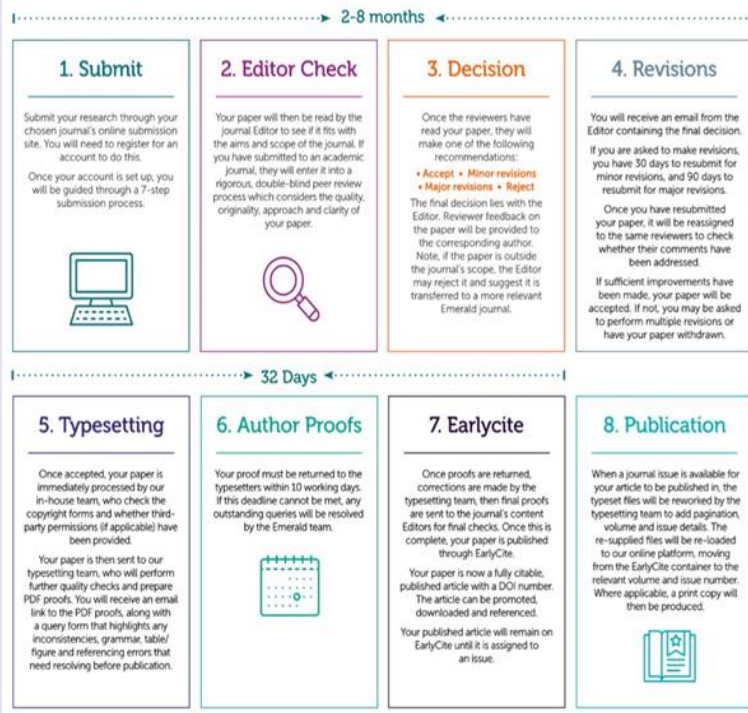

Why Are Our Articles Rejected?

Professor David Phillips (University of Oxford), former Editor of the Oxford Review of Education, has offered the following explanations: •

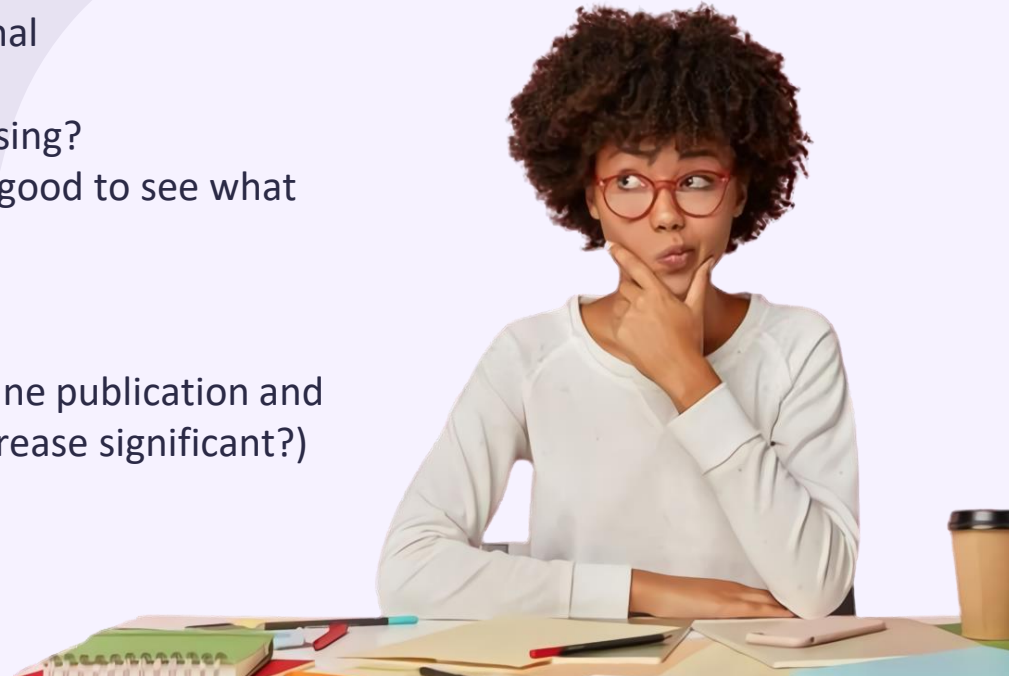
- The article is not ready; it is only a draft.
- The article is too parochial (it will not appeal to a wider, international audience).
- The article is written in poor English.
- The manuscript is poorly prepared.
- The article is too short or too long (check the article length specified in author guidelines).
- The article has been submitted to the wrong journal (the material will not be relevant to the readers -check the aims and scope of a journal before submitting to it).
- Nothing new is stated or found.
- The article is under-theorized.
- It is not properly a journal article and would be better suited to another form of publication.

CHOOSING THE RIGHT JOURNAL



Choosing the Right Journal

- If possible, find journal in the reputable publisher and check in the Scopus Database, SJR, or WOS
- Read carefully the scope of the journal
- Read topics that cover the respective journal
- See who are the editors and reviewers
- Review volumes and issues → What is missing?
- Read min 10 papers of that journal → It is good to see what they accept
- Read the guidelines
- The type of article
- Journal's performance (track record time line publication and the number of article every issue – Is it increase significant?)
- Choose open access or closed access



Choosing the Right Journal

Journal Finder

- Some publishers provide the journal finder to find journals that most closely match your title/abstract

Journal metrics

- Help to select the most appropriate journal
- Types of journal metrics: speed, reach, and impact (Ex. SNIP, SJR, Citescore, IF, Eigenfactor)

Pay attention to predatory journals

- A publishing business model that is **suspected** to exploit authors and involves:
 1. charging publication fees to authors without checking (or minimal checking) articles for quality and legitimacy
 2. providing the accelerated editorial process
 3. publishing services associated with legitimate journals (open access or not).
- List maintained by **Jeffrey Beall** (aka Beall's List)

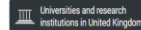

- *Don't force submit in journals that are not the topic*
- *Don't think that paid journals are definitely easy to accept*
- *Don't ask: are there slots? when is the LOA issued? Even though it's only been submitted for 1 day --> High confidence*
- *Following the structure of a thesis or research report*
- *Check your paper to the proofreader*
- *Make Collaboration*
- *Never think of committing a violation (unethical publications)*
- *Create a "list" as an alternative to a journal that will be sent a manuscript, the order of one is priority and so on. Remember: good article will find its right home (journal)*

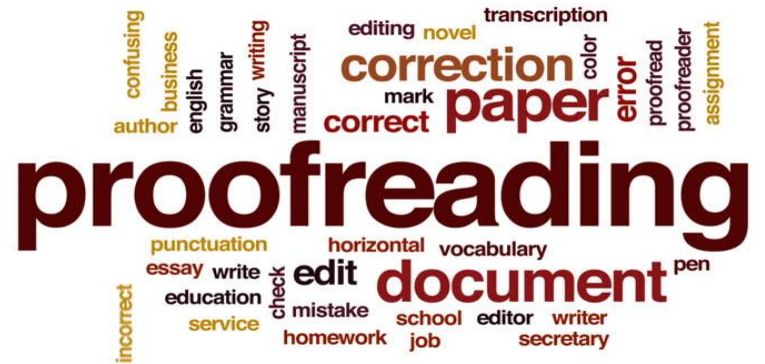

1	<p>Introduction Section:</p> <p>Briefly, the clarification points have been separately presented, however, a lack of integrated linkage with self-efficacy and entrepreneurial resilience makes the research rationale a bit weak. Except for the definition of self-efficacy and entrepreneurial resilience, the clarification about why self-efficacy and entrepreneurial resilience is so important for (ex)prisoners, is still insufficient. Please see the detailed comments below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> In the second paragraph, this should be explaining the importance of prison entrepreneurship education to respond to people's traditional perception of a prison (Hackler, 2017). It is a bit unclear why do you use Marris et al.'s (2013) study that emphasizes the influence of (general) entrepreneurship education on students. The purpose of designing (general) entrepreneurship education is different to the purpose of designing prison entrepreneurship programs. The research gap has been clearly identified with evidence; however, the research rationale is still vague. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Based on the research focus, for example, it is unclear about what is entrepreneurship learning programs (Akhtar and Golra, 2021)? What is the difference between entrepreneurship learning programs and traditional skills training programs? 	<p>Thank you for your response. We have changed the reference to focus on entrepreneurship education in prison institutions (Please see the second paragraph of the introduction) Morris et al. 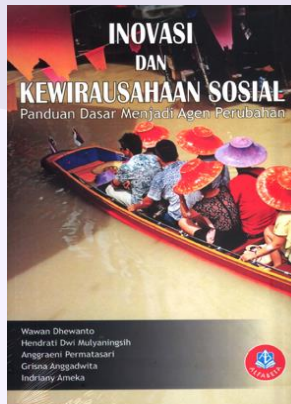

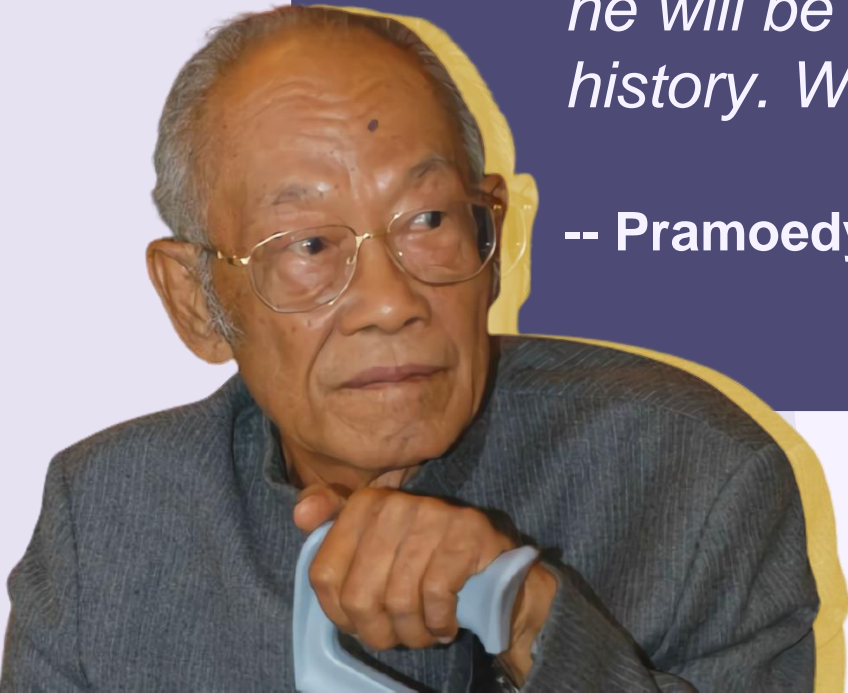
